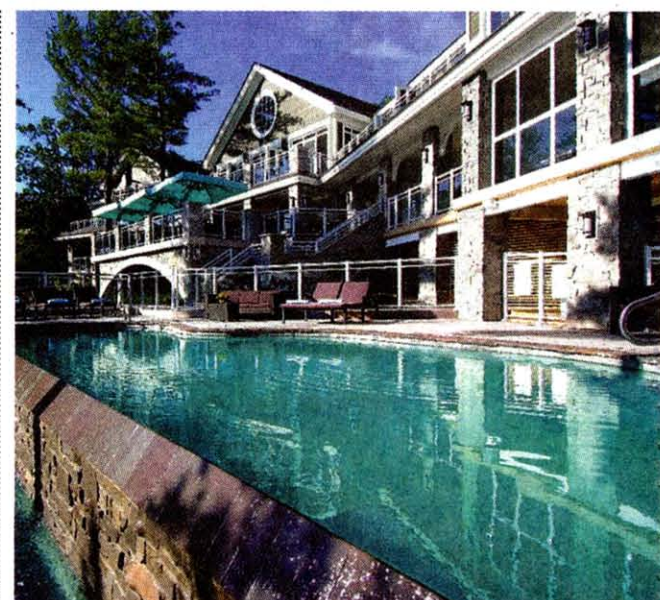
GOLFERS
